We have three more meeting before the December meeting and the election of officers. All the positions are available including the board of directors. If you know some one or wish to run let Tom Rogers know.

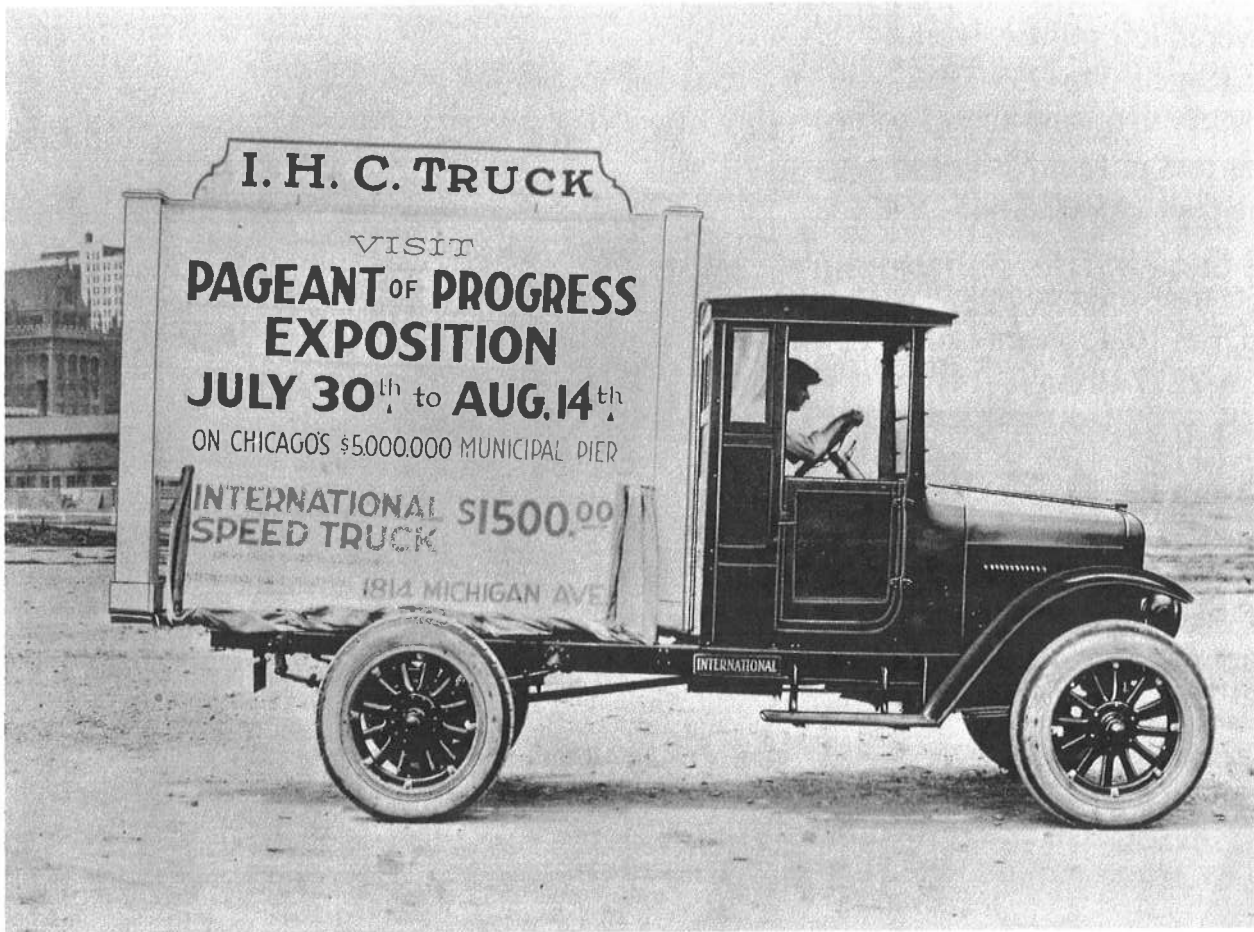
On a sad note we would like to give John Rienzo Jr. and his family our condolences on the lose of his brother.
