**FROM THE PAST: POPULAR MECHANICS DECEMBER 1954**

#### **Auto Transport Uses Special Alloys to Reduce Weight 8000 Pounds**

Lightweight metals and alloys are used in a new automobile-transport truck that weighs 8000 pounds less than the conventional models. Aluminum and light steel alloys replace heavier metals in runways, skids, fenders, wheels and trailer body, re-

ducing weight by three tons. This permits the elimination of a third axle on the unit, saving another ton. According to the developers, the machined-aluminum wheels stay in perfect balance, allowing tires a 100,000-mile run before recapping.





The Truck shown above was once the pride of the Highway Department fleet in the Town Of Sullivan, Madison County. It is a 1958 Walters Snow Fighter FGBS. Usually it carried a Frink V-plow and a right side wing. The sander was added in the early 1980's in lieu of the standard ballast box body. At that same time the original Waukesha 145-GZ 779 cu. In. gas engine was removed and replaced with a Cummins NH-220 diesel. The original Walters six speed transmission was mated to the Cummins. Take note of the nice job they did mounting the heavy duty remote outside air cleaner. Why the extra fuel tank was mounted far back on the frame is anyone's guess. It is also anyone's guess as to where this truck is today. Perhaps used by some contractor to plow out some supermarket parking lot or riding around central Asia as a Toyota pickup.....TGR
