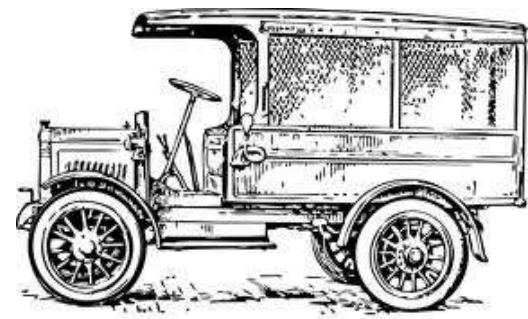

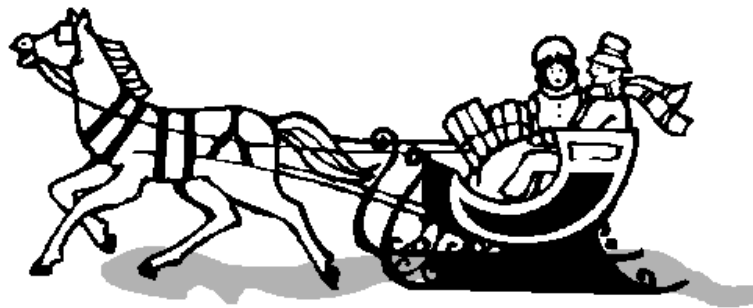

NOMINATION OF OFFICERS

Election of officers is scheduled for the December 15th meeting. Nominations take place from the time you receive this newsletter (October) until November 30th 2016. The following is a summary of the officer's responsibilities that should be carefully reviewed before you nominate someone or accept an office.

The nomination procedure is as follows:

Any eligible CNY/ATHS member may nominate him or herself or another member.

If you chose to nominate a fellow member, please check with that person to verify their willingness to accept the responsibility of the office for which you are nominating them.

Nominations will be accepted by telephone or mail until November 30th 2016. Contact Tom Rogers at 315-733-3282.

Please give your name and telephone number, the nominee's name and office for which you wish to nominate them for. A form is enclosed with this newsletter. The committee's job is to qualify the nominee's presented. The slate may contain two or more nominees for each office. A committee meeting will be held after November 30th to prepare a slate to be announced at the meeting on December 15th.

At the December meeting, **ONLY** eligible members (current dues paid to the CNY Chapter and the ATHS Nationals) shall be allowed to vote.

The nominating chairman will conduct the balloting. He will open the floor to any additional nominations for each office. A nominated member from the floor **MUST** be present to run for office.

If there is a contest for any or all offices, ballots shall be passed out and the committee will tally the results. In the event of a tie, the president shall cast the deciding vote. If there is no contest for any particular office, the Nominating Committee chairman will request the Secretary to cast one vote on behalf of the membership.

- **PRESIDENT:** The President presides over all meetings, appoints a chairman of all committees and gives direction to the Chapter. The person holding this position should have as much flex-time as possible. He/She needs to be able to go out and meet members, attend local and regional shows, contact various individuals and agencies connected with the Chapter business. Travel expenses, telephone costs and time are elements that should be considered by anyone considering this office. Dedication, willingness, and leadership are very important to this position.
- **VICE-PRESIDENT:** Though this office doesn't demand as much time as the Presidency, the person holding this position must be dedicated to doing a lot of behind the scenes tasks. The VP attends ALL meetings, works on committees, organizes functions, supports and represents the President during an absence. This person helps share the load of Chapter business. This also requires some accessibility to attend Executive meeting and availability to consult with the President and other officers when necessary.
- **SECRETARY:** The Secretary should attend all meetings, keep accurate Minutes of meetings, read correspondence and respond regarding any Chapter business, keep accurate records as to activities, meetings, and functions, provide information for the Newsletter and information pertinent to the ATHS.
- **TREASURER:** The Treasurer will maintain accurate records and keep the finances of the Organization up to date. This person should attend all meetings and present a written report of business and finance monthly at those meetings. All finances (cash, checks, etc.) should be directed to the Treasurer, as well as any accounts payable (documents by signed receipts). A checking account will be maintained on a continuous basis. The records are audited annually by the officers and an annual report prepared and presented to the National Chapter of the ATHS. These records are to be maintained carefully, as failure to keep them monthly and annually in an accurate fashion could result in the suspension of our Chapter.

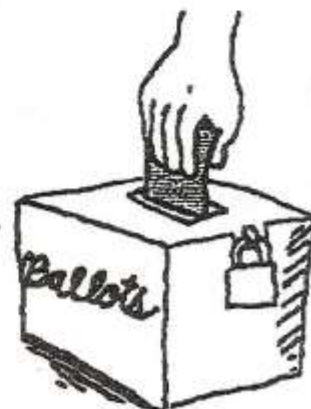
Every officer needs to give extra effort to maintain the growth and quality of the CNY/ATHS.
