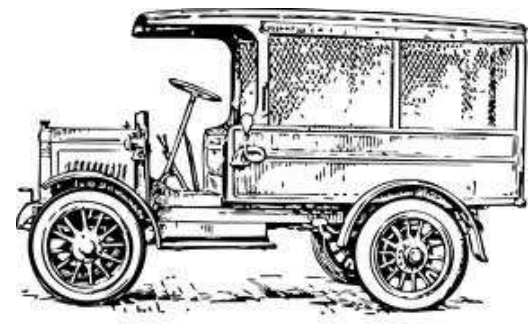

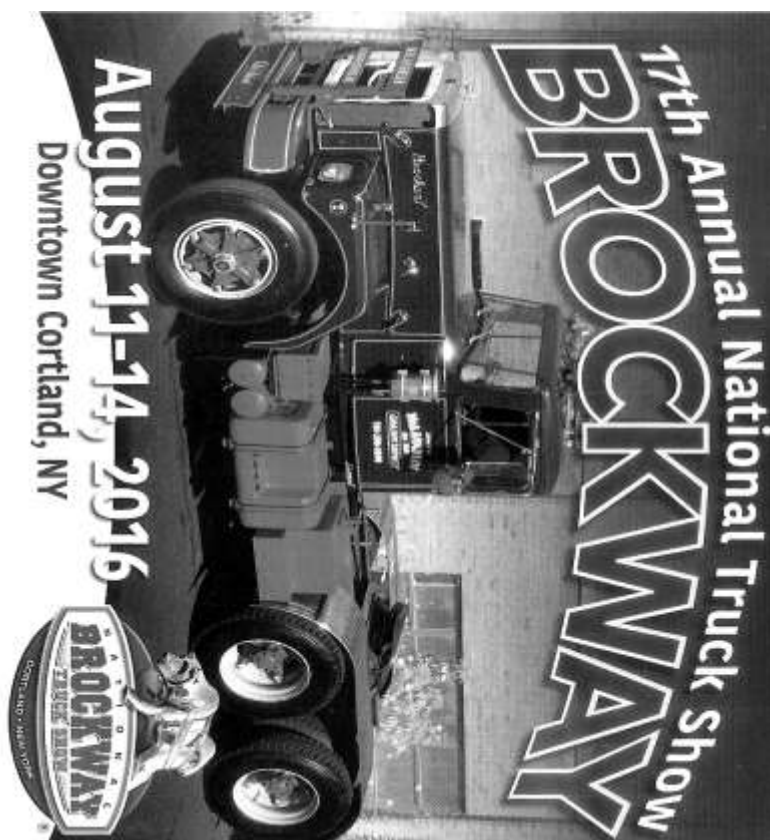

- 1946** July 12th Spicer manufacturing is renamed Dana Corp.
- 1956** The Federal Aid Highway Act was enacted to construct the interstate highway system.

ORGANIZATIONAL OVERVIEW

OUR STORY

Clear Path for Veterans was founded in January 2011 by Co-Founders: Melissa Spicer; Stephen Kinne, MD (ret), MPH Col (ret) USAF; and Melinda Sorrentino. The three were inspired to bring life to our current Dogs2Vets program when they started the organization. Neither Melissa and Melinda have served in the military, but each has personal ties and experiences with members of the military that have inspired them to embark on the Clear Path mission. During the start, Melissa and Melinda committed personal funds to purchase and renovate our campus. This helped provide a homebase for Clear Path for Veterans to position itself as Upstate New York's Veteran Resource & Outreach Center.

In June of 2013, Co-Founder Steve Kinne resumed his retirement. Four years since its founding, Clear Path for Veterans now serves as a single point of contact for Veterans, active service members and their families to connect with their community, find information, volunteer opportunities, resources, programs, and services that make a positive difference in their lives close to home.

GROWTH SINCE 2011

In 2011, our Dogs2Vets programs served 8 Veterans with over 450 visitors despite our extensive renovation efforts. Veterans traveled weekly from as far as Buffalo, Fort Drum, and Binghamton. Today, we offer five additional programs with individualized services to support the individual's need. We serve military members and Veterans from all over New York State concentrating on an 18 county catchment area that surrounds our headquarters. We now serve an average of 1,000 Veterans a month and receive over 25 inquiries a day.

Today, we currently operate on a fully funded annual budget of \$1.6 million dollars with a volunteer force of over 419. Volunteer hours recorded in 2014 totaled 8,142 and is part of our aggressive outreach and effectiveness. In our first year, the annual operating budget was just \$110,042 with the needs of the organization accomplished by a volunteer force of 50.



LOCATION

Clear Path is conveniently located in beautiful Central New York, straddling both Onondaga and Madison Counties, just 13 miles southeast of the Syracuse VA Medical Center. Our comfortable and family-centered environment offers a place for future, present, and past warriors to connect with peers of similar experiences. Clear Path is located 90 miles south of Fort Drum and 11 miles east of the Army, Marine Corps, Navy and Air Force National Guard, and Reserve Units.
